The core of the JASC mission is the search for mutual understanding. I believe that the understanding achieved through JASC is beyond just mutual understanding between individuals, but includes a greater understanding of oneself, one's home country, and certainly a greater understanding of the world beyond college.

Most American students come to JASC focused on learning more about Japan. Yet starting from day one when they meet their fellow Amadeles from Alaska and Arkansas to Hawaii and New Jersey they are amazed at the diversity the U.S. has to offer. Then JASC travels, as they did this year, throughout the U.S. and students are even more impressed.

Touring their home country with people from another nation gives students the chance to view it through a new outsider perspective. This perspective builds a greater understanding that allows for a more open view of others and creates the opportunity for true mutual understanding. 
